課程內容概要 Course Content Synopsis	■課程內容概要本課程以閱、聽、讀、析國際主要英文媒體為內涵,以達到參與者知天下事的宗旨。這些媒體包括CNN、BBC、經濟學人、華爾街、彭博等;選取的新聞素材,以平衡涵蓋多元領域為要,例如政治、經濟、環境、科學、文化、藝術、文學等。藉由每週的接觸探索,參與者將熟悉這個多元、動態的當代世界,並且對於全球性的重要議題,能培養出覺知與分析的能力。本課程將輔助參與者成為更好的地球公民,具備開放的眼界、整體的世界觀、和深度的文化素養。 This course provides the selected up-to-date news materials from international English media, such as CNN, BBC, The Economist, The Wall Street Journal, Bloomberg, etc The chosen materials will cover all fields——politics, economics, environment, science, culture, art, literature, etc Through weekly watching, listening, reading, and analyzing the materials, the participants are exposed to the contemporary world in its multiplicity and mobility. The participants, furthermore, are to develop not only an awareness of significant global issues but also the ability to analyze them. On the whole, this course is designed to equip the participants to become better global citizens, with open-mindedness, holis tic world views, and cultural literacy.
